Checklist for Applying:

Employed for 2 or more years with Marion County Public Schools.

Must be enrolled in college, possess an AA and are currently working on a bachelor's degree.

Declared major or minor is education and will lead toward teacher certification.

Provide a copy of official transcript

Must be enrolled for at least 6 semester hours per semester.

Complete application including information on awards or special recognitions, community involvement, volunteer/work experience in education, income and special circumstances

Attach essay response

Recommendation from principal at your school or department supervisor

Signed Letter of Agreement to teach in Marion County for at least three years immediately after graduation.

Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5

Submit a total of 5 application packets. Only one copy of the transcript is needed.

Applications must be received by August 24, 2018 at 4:00pm.

No late applications will be accepted.

Applicants may be called in for a personal interview- date and time to be determined.

Scholarship recipients will be reimbursed \$500.00 per semester for up to 5 semesters, including summer. In order to be reimbursed, recipients must submit a final transcript to the Foundation and must have earned a C or better in all classes.

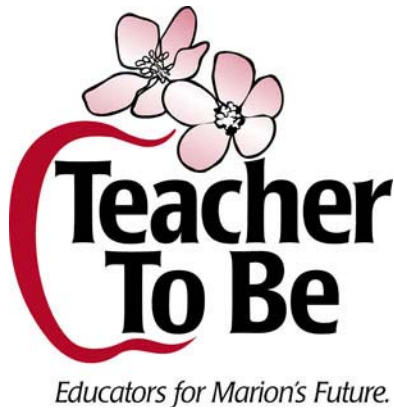
