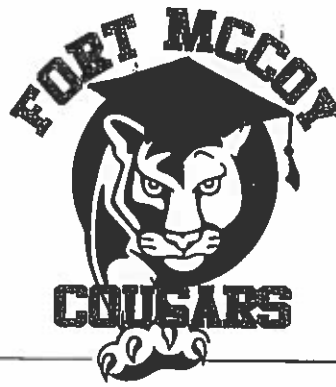

- Applicant must be attending a 2 year college, 4 year college, or Technical College
- Scholarship money will be paid directly to the institution
- Student must maintain a full-time enrollment status with the institution for a full academic year
- Student needs to be willing to attend an in person interview
- Student should complete an essay following the essay guidelines below
- Must maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA
- Current transcript
- 2 letters of recommendation (1 letter from school personnel and 1 letter from a community leader)
